This gift will purchase a vital signs monitor. The vital signs monitor is a small, transportable unit that staff take to the patient's bedside. The monitor measures a patient's vital signs including blood pressure, temperature, and the oxygen level in their blood. The monitor allows for a quick assessment to be completed. While in hospital, patients have their vitals taken frequently, sometimes every hour which makes this item in high demand.

Since 1952, through charitable donations like this, Kawartha Credit Union has continued to prove its commitment to making the communities it serves better places to live. Kawartha takes pride in demonstrating to its members that the same kind of caring and dedication that goes into what they do in the community also takes place at the branch level.
