

# **Get Ready for the 5th Annual Reindeer Fun Run, in support of YMCA Northumberland and the Northumberland Hills Hospital Foundation**

Following the Fun Run, participants are invited to the Dutch Oven, where Lauren and Bruce MacLean will serve complimentary coffee, hot chocolate and cookies.

Entry is \$15 per person or \$35 per family. Participants will receive a Fun Run memento, and any donation over \$20 will be eligible for an income tax receipt. The event is open to runners and walkers of all ages, and all registered participants will have a chance to win great prizes.
