Northumberland Hills Hospital celebrates Pharmacist Awareness Week March 5-11, 2007

Northumberland County, Monday, March 5, 2007 - Did you know that the average Canadian fills (or refills) 12 prescriptions a year? People under 30 fill five or less, while those in their 60s or 70s fill, on average, 22. Canada has 29,500 licensed pharmacists practicing in 7,785 community pharmacies, in 300 hospitals, and in consulting, government, academia and industry.

March 5 to 11 is Pharmacist Awareness Week in Canada, and at NHH activities to mark the important role the Pharmacy Department's drug experts play in the Hospital and in the community at large are in full swing.

With a total of 12 full- and part-time staff and combined experience of 235 years, the Pharmacy Department at the Northumberland Hills Hospital is open seven days a week to make sure the right medications get to the right patient at the right time. Pharmacists have expanded their role within the healthcare system in recent years, and at NHH this is particularly true. In addition to dispensing medications, NHH pharmacists provide a range of services and counseling to medical staff, patients and their families to ensure effective use of drugs and other healthcare products.

Pharmacists discuss possible side effects, provide advice on what foods, drinks or activities should be avoided while on a particular medication, and offer advice on what to do if you miss a dose. They also offer help for a variety of other health concerns, including guidance for conditions such as diabetes, asthma, high blood pressure or high cholesterol. A pharmacist can also provide sound, up-to-date advice on staying well and preventing disease.

A poster display explaining the Northumberland Hills Hospital's Pharmacy Department's services will be found in the Main St. Bistro throughout the week, and reporters interested in getting a personal "behind the scenes" tour are welcome.
