NORTHUMBERLAND – The Youth Cares Committee of the Northumberland Hills Hospital Foundation is pleased to announce the return of a unique charity event. On Saturday, May 12th, 2007, **Survivor Health Hustle 2** will take place at Victoria Park & Beach in Cobourg.

Survivor Health Hustle 2 will be a fun, energetic event consisting of seven mini-challenges that require skill and teamwork. The challenges include an inflatable obstacle course, a beach obstacle course, a blind-folded stretcher race, and a buried puzzle relay. Teams will be awarded points for completing each challenge, and the team with the highest score after completing all challenges will be declared the winner.

Competitors in **Survivor Health Hustle 2** will register teams of six people. There is a minimum entry fee of \$240 per team. To raise funds, participants will collect pledges from members of the community. The event is limited to 30 teams of six people.

Funds raised during **Survivor Health Hustle 2** will be directed toward the purchase of a new cardiac monitor/defibrillator for the Emergency Room at Northumberland Hills Hospital.
