

Canadian Tire Presents the Northumberland Street Hockey Festival

Northumberland County – Cobourg resident Damien Cunningham is seeking hockey players of all ages and gender to participate in the Northumberland Street Hockey Festival, a county-wide event in support of Northumberland Hills Hospital.

Sponsored by Canadian Tire, the Street Hockey Festival will take place on May 5, 2007 from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. at Legion Fields in Cobourg and Main Street in Colborne. On the day of the event, teams of four to five players (teams of five are recommended) will battle for local bragging rights and renown.

Last year, the Street Hockey Festival was held in Cobourg and raised \$500 towards medical equipment for the hospital.

Recognizing that the hospital serves all of west Northumberland, event-organizers expanded this year's event to include Cramahe Township with a simultaneous tournament in downtown Colborne.

"This year, the Street Hockey Festival is truly a county-wide event," says Cunningham. "We hope to expand even further next year by offering a third tournament in Port Hope."
