NORTHUMBERLAND – The **Youth Cares** Committee of the Northumberland Hills Hospital Foundation is pleased to announce details of a unique new charity event involving the hottest game on the planet. On Saturday, May 10th, 2008, ***The Wii Care Cup*** will take place at North Shore Lanes in Cobourg.

The Wii Care Cup will be a fun-filled Nintendo Wii tournament for participants of all ages. Competitors in ***The Wii Care Cup*** will compete in two age categories using games from the Wii Sports library. The Junior Division will include players 13 years of age and younger, while the Senior Division will include all participants 14 and over. A ***Wii Care Cup*** Champion will be crowned in each division.

There is a minimum entry fee of \$20 in pledges per player. To raise funds, participants are encouraged to collect pledges from members of the community. For every \$50 raised in pledges participants will receive a ballot to enter a draw to win a Nintendo Wii system.

Funds raised during ***The Wii Care Cup*** will be directed toward the purchase of the MR (magnetic resonance) imaging equipment now operating at the Northumberland Hills Hospital.

“We are excited about hosting this new event at North Shore Lanes”, says Kate Tukendorf, **Youth Cares** Committee co-chair, “There’s lots of room to set up the 8 Wii stations right on the bowling lanes, plus the other activities we have planned including Guitar Hero and Dance Revolution challenge areas.”
