NORTHUMBERLAND – Cobourg artist Wayne Mondok will be having a fundraising art show at the C. Gordon King Centre (Cobourg Public Library) on Friday, May 8th and Saturday, May 9th, 2009 and everyone is invited. This is a fundraising event to benefit the Northumberland Hills Hospital.

Wayne has been a full-time professional artist for over twenty years. While originally from Toronto, he now calls Cobourg home and he wants to support for the west Northumberland community.

“There will be something for everyone at this show as it will feature mostly smaller, affordable works, although a few larger pieces will be there as well,” says Mondok. “The paintings will span a variety of subjects, ranging from landscapes (Canadian west coast, Canadian east coast, Northumberland area), still life, wildlife, and figurative work,” he added. These smaller paintings will be priced around \$400. Most of Wayne’s art is done in acrylic paints, but he also uses oil, water-colour, and gouache paints.

Twenty-five percent of all sales and commissions will be donated to the Northumberland Hills Hospital.
