Annual “Walk and Roll” to take place this Friday, May 8 at NHH**

NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, Monday, May 5, 2008 – NHH’s physiotherapy team has joined forces with Health for Life again this year to organize the annual *NHH Walk and Roll* in celebration of National Physiotherapy Month.

Registration is FREE and a range of prizes will be up for grabs for staff, volunteers and community members alike who lace up their sneakers and head out on the one-kilometre path around the hospital. Participants get to “roll” giant dice at four stations along the route and prizes will be awarded to those with the highest score. The whole route only takes about 15 minutes to complete, and the excitement is sure to get your heart rate up!

The walk begins at 11:30 AM on Friday, May 8 and walkers simply need to show up at the registration table at the main stairs by the hospital’s Main Street Bistro between 11:30 AM and 12:30 PM. Physiotherapy staff and hospital Auxiliary volunteers will be on hand to direct walkers on their way!

Walking is a healthy, weight-bearing exercise that can provide a total body workout. As a “health-promoting hospital” NHH is proud to host this annual event.
