



## G.P. Anesthetist

Northumberland Hills Hospital is currently recruiting for a G.P. Anesthetist. As a key member of our Surgical Program, you will join a group of three G.P. Anesthetists. Opened in 2003, NHH is a 103-bed hospital offering 24/7 in-house general surgery, obstetrics/gyn and ophthalmology service. In addition, there is a well established program of visiting surgeons including plastics, ENT, dentistry and orthopedics. There is a 24-hour epidural service with approximately 300 epidurals per year. NHH has a 6-bed Intensive Care Unit with state-of-the-art ventilators and BiPaps. The anesthesia service share on-call (1:4) and associated responsibilities which cover general anesthesia in the surgical suite five days per week. This group also share the responsibilities associated with the running of the onsite Pre-Operative Clinic for anesthetic assessments, and provide strong support for airway management and ventilation – both invasive and non-invasive – in the Emergency Department and ICU.

This position requires an Anesthetist to perform full scope of practice anesthesiology. Interested candidates should be registered (or eligible for licensure) with the Ontario College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario. The hospital shall consider applicants that may wish to practice in other services, such as Emergency Department, and locum arrangements.

NHH employs approximately 600 people and relies on the additional support provided by physicians and volunteers.
