



GENERAL SURGEON

Northumberland Hills Hospital is currently recruiting for a General Surgeon. As a key member of our Surgical Program, you will join an active group of two other general surgeons. Opened in 2003, NHH is a well-designed, well-staffed and modern 103-bed hospital offering 24/7 general surgery, obstetrics/gyn and ophthalmology care. We have 4 GP-anaesthesiologists, offering a postoperative pain service, ICU ventilator care and perioperative consultation. Orthopedics, otolaryngology, plastics and urology services are provided by visiting surgeons. We have a 6-bed Level 2 intensive care unit with internal medicine support.

The surgical suite has high definition endoscopic and laparoscopic facilities. There are 3 operating theatres, and a 16 bed recovery room, well suited for an efficient and high-volume practice. The general surgery service shares on-call according to HOCC guidelines and provides Day Surgery and inpatient surgery service options for adult and pediatric patients.

The Northumberland Hills Hospital's Diagnostic Imagingin Department is among the most technologically advanced for a community hospital of this size, fully digitalized, featuring MR, enhanced CT and PACS.

This is an ideal opportunity for an individual with interest in a varied clinical practice, including breast surgery, working in a culture of patient safety and excellence. About Northumberland Hills Hospital - Located approximately 100 kilometres east of Toronto, Northumberland Hills Hospital (NHH) delivers a broad range of acute, post-acute, outpatient and diagnostic services. Acute services include emergency and intensive care, medical/surgical care, and obstetrical care. Post-acute services include restorative care, interim long-term care, rehabilitation and palliative care. Mental health care, chemotherapy, dialysis and 16 other ambulatory care clinics are offered on an outpatient basis through partnerships with regional centres and nearby specialists. NHH offers a full range of diagnostic services, including magnetic resonance imaging (MRI), computed tomography (CT) and mammography. The hospital serves the catchment area of west Northumberland County. A mixed urban and rural population of approximately 60,000 residents, west Northumberland comprises the Town of Cobourg, the Municipality of Port Hope and the townships of Hamilton, Cramahe and Alnwick/Haldimand. NHH employs approximately 600 people and relies on the additional support provided by physicians and volunteers.
